Aziuddin Ahmad - Biography



Aziuddin Ahmad has a background in electrical and electronics engineering (Kings College London 1977), nuclear reactor science and engineering (Queen Mary College London 1979) and reactor neutron physics (Imperial College London 1982). After completing his PhD, he served at Malaysia's Tun Ismail Atomic Research Centre, then switched to financial services

before returning to Kings College London to read law. He was awarded the Cameron Waller Prize in Law in 1991.

In March 2007 Aziuddin Ahmad entered academia as a full-time professor at the Graduate School of Management (GSM), University Putra Malaysia (UPM). He teaches Risk Management, Islamic Finance, Human & Corporate Governance as the founding instructor. His research interests are in Holistic Knowledge Acquisition & Epistemology, Geo-Political Economy, Islamic Financial & Monetary Systems and Human Advancement. His reading and research interests cover the New Sciences of Quantum Theory, Complexity, Chaos, Cosmology, Parapsychology & the Sentient Heart. He is studying their relationships with Decision Making Process in this Business Call Life, Mysticism, Ontology, Eschatology, Consciousness and Al Tawhid.

His first book *Human Governance: A Paradigm Shift in Governing Corporations* co-authored with Associate Professor Arfah Salleh PhD was recently published by MPH. Other than his industry and now academia involvement, Aziuddin has had on-the-field experiences in making hard decisions when managing victims of after-effects of war and earthquake. He jointly initiated relief and rehabilitation, and capacity building efforts first-hand while in the refugee camps and tent sites of Afghanistan, North West Frontier Province of Pakistan, and earthquake disaster zone of Bam in Iran while serving AlBukhary Foundation.
