What do the fees cover?

The 2015 fees are CHF 60,000 for tuition and CHF 25,000 for all program and project related fees including:

- all books, cases and teaching materials
- personal development elective
- travel expenses for the Discovery Expedition and International Consulting Projects
- community building activities
- a four-course lunch at IMD five days per week
- participation in selected executive events
