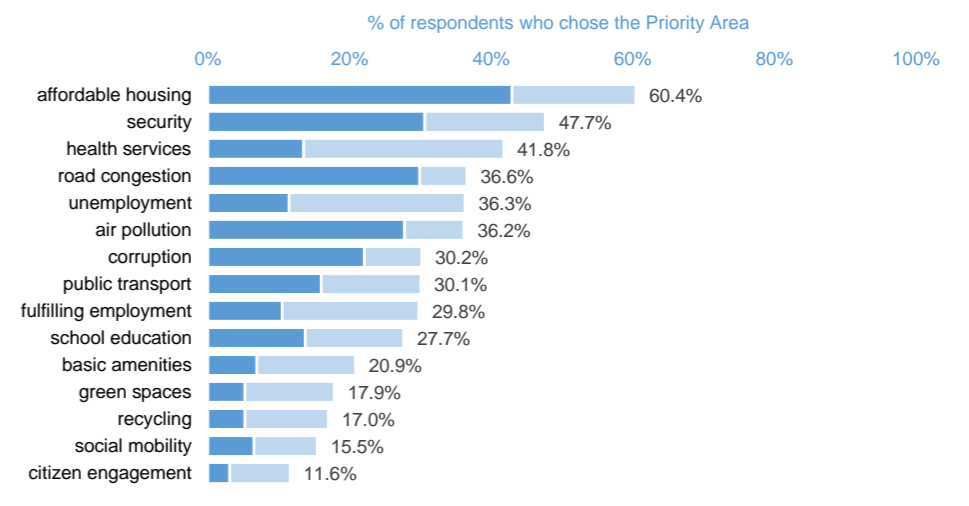

PRIORITY AREAS

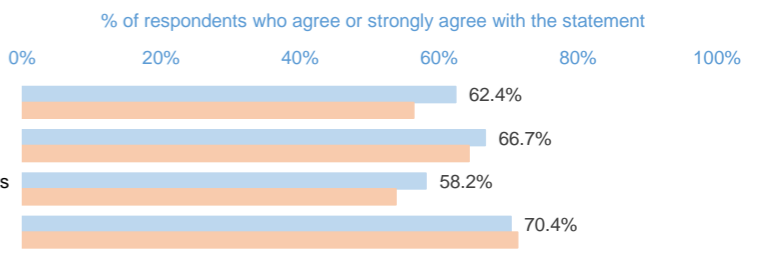

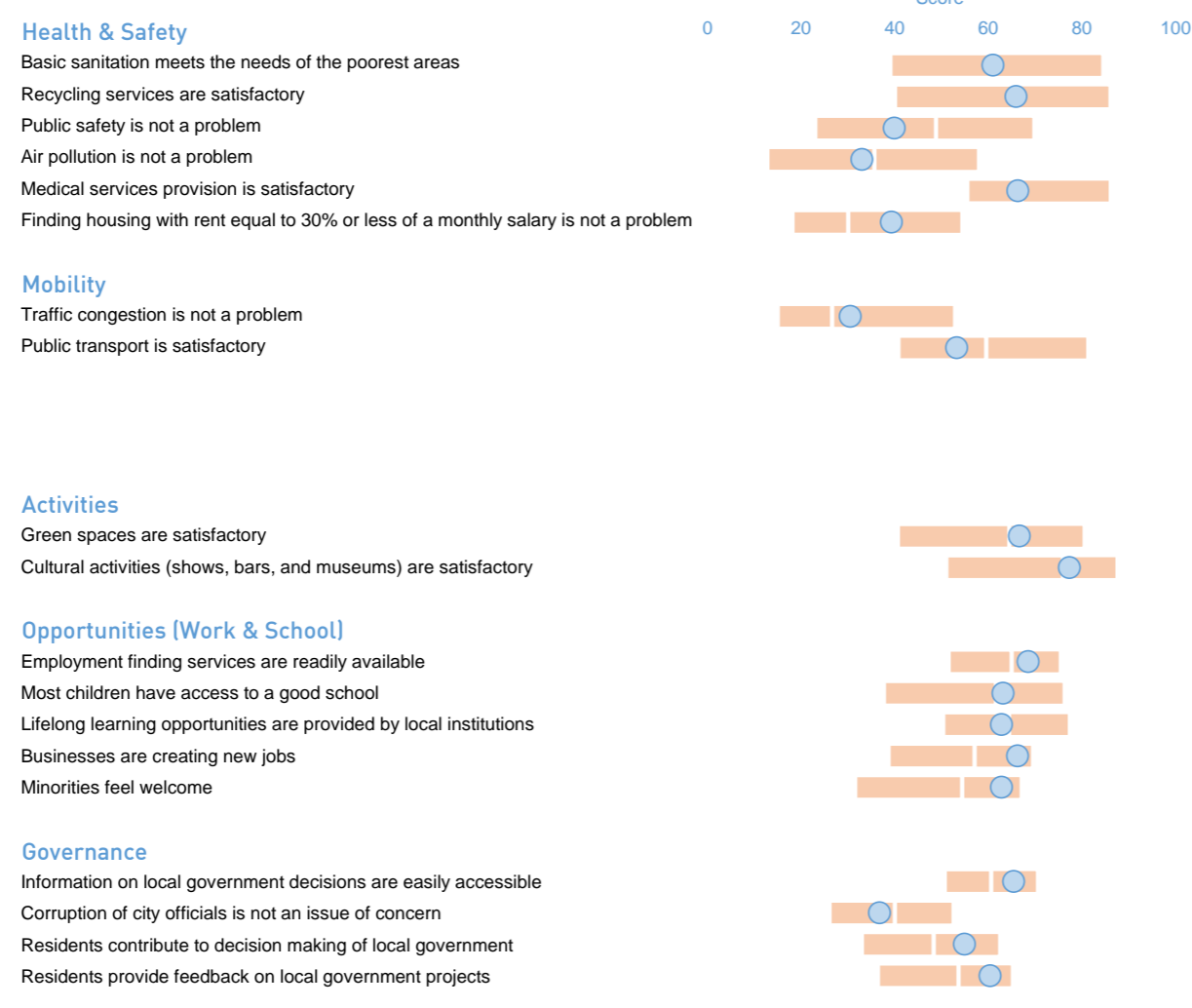
